Players per team

- Recommended 9 per team
- Max of 12 / min of 8

Age Divisions

- Opens only – must be 15+ to participate

Time slots

- 6.15pm
- 7.25pm
- 8.35pm

Game Duration

- 4 x 15 min Quarters
- 2 min half time
- 1 min quarter time

Representative players

- There is no cap on the number of representative players you may have for this competition.

Replacement/Fill in Players

- Team lists will be taken from registered players on Netball Connect.
- Bylaw section 8.16 - a player may only fill in once without registering for the competition
- Fill in's will be required to pay a one off match fee at venue - \$15 per game.
- For all regular draw games, replacement players are to report to the office **PRIOR** to the game to sign replacement player form and gain approval to play. Failure to comply may result in loss of points.
- For all Finals games- if a replacement player/fill in is required- By Law 12.4 – teams can apply in writing to the Management committee for medical exemption.

Live Scoring

- All teams must provide a scorer
- The Netball Connect App will be used for scoring
- Ensure you have assigned a manager in Netball Connect

Uniforms

- All teams must play in Netball dress that has been approved by the Management Committee
- Stick Velcro bibs provided by team.
- Velcro Bib hire may be arranged by contacting South Coast Netball Association

Umpires

- Umpires are provided and included in your registration fee.
- RESPECT OUR UMPIRES AT ALL TIMES.
- South Coast will remove players or spectators that do not respect our officials.
- If you have an umpire in your team interested in umpiring before/after games please contact South Coast.

Forfeits

Teams must notify the Competition Coordinator as soon as possible via competitions@southcoastnetball.org.au

Late notifications (after 12pm on game day) please text – 0432 172 667.

All forfeits will be issued a \$100 forfeit fine. The fine must be paid within 2 weeks of forfeit to ensure your place remains in the competition.

If a Grand Final is forfeited regardless of the notice a \$150 fine will apply.

Teams must have a minimum of five (5) players available at the scheduled start time, or a forfeit may be awarded.

If you are facing a shortage of players, please contact South Coast as soon possible. We may have players wishing to join a team.

Repeated forfeits may result in further review and action by the Association.

Competition Structure

- Following all 16 round games teams will be split into top 4 and bottom 4.
- 2 week finals –
Div 1 - 1 v 4 and 2 v 3
Div 2 – 5 v 8 and 6 v 7
- Followed by Div 1 and 2 Grand finals

Finals Extra time

- 2-minute break
- 1 x 5-minute play

If scores remain tied:

- NC will pause and the scorer must hit continue
- Play continues until one team leads by 2 goals
