Players per team

- Recommend 8-9 players per team
- Boys Max 3 per team (South Coast Netball Association By-Law- Section 9.7a)
- Boys 2 on court at any one time. Must be in different thirds (e.g. GD/GA and GS/GK OR GS/GK and C)) (South Coast Netball Association By-Law-Section 9.7b and c)

Age Divisions

Opens (11+) – divisions
 *teams will be placed in divisions based on age and ability at the discretion of the Management Committee. Divisions will be reviewed once season commences and may change if necessary

Time Slots

- 6.30pm and 7.30pm

Game Duration

- 12-minute Quarters
- 2 min guarter time break
- 2 minute half time

Representative Players

- Each team to have a maximum of 5 rep players per team.
- Representative players include:
 - A State Age player from any Association
 - A premier league player from any Association
 - Does not include development players or Training partners.

Replacement/Fill in Players

- Team lists will be taken from registered players on Netball Connect.
- Bylaw section 8.16- a player may only fill in once without registering for the competition
- A replacement/fill in player must be from a lower grade
- For all regular draw games, replacement players are to report to the office
 <u>PRIOR</u> to the game to sign replacement player form and gain approval to play.
 Failure to comply may result in loss of points.
- For all Finals round games- if a replacement player/fill in is required- By Law 12.4 teams can apply in writing to the Management committee for medical exemption.

Piercings and nails

As per By-Law 8.2 – Strictly no taped fingernails, piercings or jewellery is permitted on court.
